“THE NIFTY 50’S”

It's a blast from the past for this year's **37th Annual Winter Festival**; “The Nifty 50's” in Historic Cedarburg, Wisconsin, **February 5 & 6.**

Cedarburg Lion's will tee-off in the snow with yellow tennis balls during the **Ice-Burg Open Golf Tournament** in Cedar Creek Park, **Saturday at 9:00 a.m.** Hop aboard the **Shake, Rattle & Roll** tractor-drawn hay wagon to view the **Sixteen Tons Ice Carving Contest** entries along Washington Avenue. It's **Now or Never** to sign up for the **Co-ed Snow-Ball Tournament Saturday at 9:00 a.m.** Entry is \$50 per team. Call **262-375-7611** for info.

Also on **Saturday** at the **Community Center** it's the **Great Balls of Fire Chili-Contest.** Both Individual and Restaurant participants will compete. Judging will begin at 11:00 am for Individual Entries. Festival attendees can sample and vote for their favorite Restaurant Entries from 11:00-4:00. Food and beverages will be served all day.

Remember how to “Stroll”? That's just what to do when the **Winter Festival Parade** kicks off at **1:00 p.m. Saturday.** The parade heads down Washington Avenue to frozen Cedar Creek for the start of the **Wake Up Little Suzie Costumed Bed Racing Competition** at **1:30 p.m. Saturday.** This hilarious cutthroat competition will be followed by the **All Shook Up Barrel Races on Ice** contest at **2:00 p.m.** Plus open **Family Skating** daily on the Mill Pond.

You'll find grown-up fun at **Cool Brews & A Taste of Cedarburg,** a chance to sample assorted specialty beers and appetizers from area restaurants at **6:30 Saturday,** followed by the music and comedy of **Pat McCurdy** at the **Cedarburg Cultural Center.** Tickets can be purchased in advance or at the door (\$19 or \$12 for concert only).

On **Sunday** morning it's the **Goody Goody Pancake Breakfast** at the **Community Center** from **8:00-11:00 a.m.,** sponsored by **Coldwell Bankers.** At **10:30,** the “under 7 set” venture outdoors to hunt for treats during the **Little Bitty Pretty One Egg Hunt** followed by **At The Hop,** a **Family Sock Hop** from **1:00-2:30.** Top dogs will compete in the **You Ain't Nothin' But A Hound Dog Alaskan Malamute Dog Weight Pull Competition, Sunday** from **11-5.** **Local Motion Outfitters** and Cedarburg Parks & Rec will host the **Be-Bop-A-Lula Snowshoe Olympics** on **Sunday** at **1:00 pm** at Washington & Mill. All competitions will require snowshoes (provided) and include Tug of War, Egg Toss, Relays, Sprint, Frisbee Toss and Inner Tube Luge.

Back for the third year is the **Cedarburg Artist's Guild's Art Show & Sale.** Varied mixed media artists will set up mini-galleries in retail establishments throughout downtown Cedarburg all weekend. On **Sunday** at **3:00 Cedarburg's Cultural Center** will host a children's theatre performance by the **Village Playhouse** of Wauwatosa (\$5.00). **The Shops of Cedar Creek Settlement** will have **live Elvis music Saturday** and **Sunday** and **free goodie bags** while **Cedar Creek Winery** offers wine sampling. **Anvil Pub & Grille** will have an outdoor “snow bar” on their patio and **Morton's Wisconsin Inn** will celebrate with live bluegrass. Many of Historic Cedarburg's charming shops will be welcoming visitors with splendid shopping opportunities, special crafts, live music and family activities.
